

Be Careful - Week 3

Another God, Another Gospel

1. What is Mormonism - founded by Joseph Smith in 1830, only true church, a counterfeit movement claiming to be Christian (Matt. 7:13-27)

2. Mormons are not Christians - They have another God, another Jesus, and another gospel (Exodus 20:1; 2 Corinthians 11:3-15; Gal. 1:6-9)

3. Christianity & Mormonism & U -

Christianity is founded on Jesus Christ, the apostles and prophets. (Matt. 16:13-18; Luke 24:44-47; Eph. 2:20; 2 Peter 1:16-21; 1 Jn. 1:1-4)

Mormonism is founded upon a false prophet and a false version of Christianity. (Matt. 7:15; Acts 20:28-31; Gal. 1:6-9)

Christians need to be disciplined and equipped in the faith (Matt. 28:18-20; Acts 2:42; 2 Timothy 2:15 & 2 Timothy 4:2-4; 1 Peter 3:15)

“2 Devote yourselves to prayer, keeping alert in it with an attitude of thanksgiving; 3 praying at the same time for us as well, that God will open up to us a door for the word, so that we may speak forth the mystery of Christ, for which I have also been imprisoned; 4 that I may make it clear in the way I ought to speak. 5 Conduct yourselves with wisdom toward outsiders, making the most of the opportunity. 6 Let your speech always be with grace, as though seasoned with salt, so that you will know how you should respond to each person.” (Colossians 4:2-6 NASB)
